


What is "Value"

- Highly Processed
- 3.06 oz = \$0.08 per ounce
- "Bite": Soft, mealy

MWWM or Whole Muscle

- \$0.45-\$0.58
- Minimally Processed
- 3.75 oz = \$0.12 per ounce
- "Bite": Juicy, Firm
